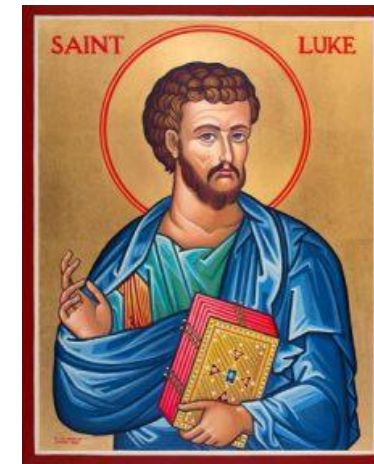

Did you know our 100 club is a game of chance?

Gambling Definition Betting.

The stake also referred to as a wager, is the sum of money one is willing to risk on a particular single bet, be it a horse racing event, a sports match or an online casino game, etc. The stake is the primary decision one makes before placing the bet. Risk gambling unpredictable element that causes things to happen one way rather than the other, uncertain risky undertaking, called a Bet, Wager, or Stake with your money.

A Game of Chance.

Not a single bet on events to win money, a game of chance is like Bingo, Raffle, Quiz night, Prize draw, Postcode lottery, National Lottery, etc. The same for our Parish fundraiser the 100 Club, this is a game of chance, with monthly draws for the winners to win money, some 36 chances to win in the year but if you are not a winner in the year, your money goes to the operating cost of the Bourne and Deepings Catholic Parish Church. This is called a Game of Chance

A reflection from Pope Francis for the Year of Prayer, for the Twenty-eighth Sunday of the Year.

We consider how our prayerful dialogue with God is meant to embrace the events of each day, in our homes, daily chores or work. There is no aspect of our everyday lives, however mundane, that cannot be offered in prayer to God and become an occasion of deeper union with him. Blaise Pascal observed that humans are so frail that even a drop of water can destroy us, yet in our fragility, prayer is a mark of our supreme grandeur, for prayer can work miracles in our world, transform lives and history, and serve the coming of God's kingdom of justice and peace. A talk by Professor David Albert Jones

Director of the Anscombe Bioethics Centre, Oxford

With Bills being introduced in the Republic of Ireland, the Isle of Man, Jersey, Scotland, and in the House of Lords, the possibility of a Bill in the House of Commons, the danger of the legalisation of assisted suicide within the British Isles has never been greater. However, at the same time, there is more and more evidence from abroad about the harms that follow if the law is changed.

Professor David Albert Jones, an internationally recognised authority on this subject, will explain why legalising assisted suicide would be a mistake.
