### **A reflection from Pope Francis for the Year of Prayer, for the Thirty second Sunday of the Year.**

In the Gospels, Elijah appears with Moses on the Mount of the Transfiguration, bearing witness to Jesus as the fulfilment of the Old Testament prophecies. Prayer and contemplation sustained the Prophet not only in moments of great success but also in the face of adversity and persecution. Elijah's experience of God in prayer culminated when the Lord appeared to him not in wind and fire, but in a quiet whisper. May we too, like the Prophet, persevere in prayer, strive to discern God's will every day of our lives, and come to experience the consolation of his presence and providential care.

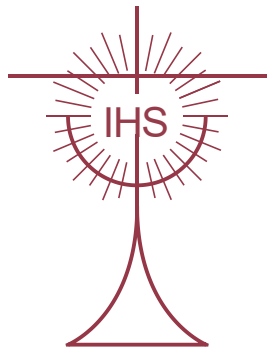
### **Morton House**

### **Euthanasia and Assisted Suicide**

“There is a special case of human dignity violation that is quieter but is swiftly gaining ground. It is unique in how it utilizes a mistaken understanding of human dignity to turn the concept of dignity against life itself. This confusion is particularly evident today in discussions surrounding euthanasia. For example, laws permitting euthanasia or assisted suicide are sometimes called “death with dignity acts.” With this, there is a widespread notion that euthanasia or assisted suicide is somehow consistent with respect for the dignity of the human person. However, in response to this, it must be strongly reiterated that suffering does not cause the sick to lose their dignity, which is intrinsically and inalienably their own. Instead, suffering can become an opportunity to strengthen the bonds of mutual belonging and gain greater awareness of the precious value of each person to the whole human family.” (Dignitas infinita, 51). Please ask your MP to stop euthanasia becoming part of our legal system:

### **Everyone will need end of life care.**

The dignity of those who are critically or terminally ill calls for all suitable and necessary efforts to alleviate their suffering through appropriate palliative care and by avoiding aggressive treatments or disproportionate medical procedures. In countries where assisted suicide has been legalised hospices have been forced to close. Ask your MP to protect our hospices and NHS against moves to introduce assisted suicide:

### **Caring for Everyone**

Pope Francis has said, “We must accompany people towards death, but not provoke death or facilitate any form of suicide. Remember that the right to care and treatment for all must always be prioritized so that the weakest, particularly the elderly and the sick, are never rejected.
