The Holy Spirit Novenas

During the time between *The Ascension and Pentecost* the Church waits with the Apostles for the coming of the Holy Spirit. Traditionally it is a time of prayer to the Holy Spirit for spiritual enlightenment and refreshment, and that the gifts received may bear fruit in our lives.

A simple prayer can be said daily:

"O Lord Jesus Christ, who, before ascending into heaven, promised to send the Holy Spirit to finish Your work in the souls of your apostles and disciples, deign to grant the same Holy Spirit to me, that He may perfect in my soul the work of your grace and your love.

Grant me: the Spirit of **wisdom**, that I may despise the perishable things of this world and aspire only after the things that are eternal:

The Spirit of **understanding**, to enlighten my mind with the light of your divine truth.

The Spirit of **counsel**, that I may ever choose the surest ways of pleasing God and gaining heaven:

The Spirit of **fortitude** that I may bear my cross with you and that I may overcome with courage all the obstacles that oppose my salvation:

The Spirit of **knowledge**, that I may know God and know myself and grow perfect in the science of the saints;

The Spirit of **piety**, that I may find the service of God sweet and amiable.

And the Spirit of **fear**, that I may be filled with a loving reverence towards God and may dread in any way to displease Him.

Mark me, dear Lord, with the sign of your the disciples, and animate me in all things with your spirit.

Amen"
