“The Commission on Palliative and End of Life Care held its first evidence session last week. It says it is clear significant gaps in provision are resulting in too many people not having access to Palliative Care and for those that do, it is coming far too late, and even then, there are significant insufficiencies in services. I agree with this assessment.” (Alicia Kearns MP)
